Thank you for your information request, received on 9 December 2019. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"I'd like to request a copy of the winning application from The Barbican and Create for Open East Festival that took place in 2013"

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information relevant to your request. The winning bid submission is attached in **Annex A**.

Please note that information has been redacted under section 40 – personal information.

Section 40(2) -personal information

- (2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if -
- (a) it constitutes personal data which does not fall within subsection (1), and
- (b) the first, second or third condition below is satisfied.

It is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information for those members of staff under Head of Service level, and for non-Legacy Corporation personnel unless consent to release the information has been received.

The section 40 exemption is absolute and is not subject to the public interest test. In this instance, the relevant condition that applies is section 40(2) whereby the information is defined as personal data within s.3(2) of the Data Protection Act 2018.
