Thank you for your information request, received on 22 October 2020. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) / Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

"[Reference to FOI 20-028] As per the comments below towards the end of the letter, please can you provide me with the evidence of who the complaint was raised to? The emails that were sent to, to whom they were sent and the dates they were sent."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request. The response letter you refer to in your request is attached in **Annex A** for reference

Please find attached in **Annex B**, the email that was sent as a result of your complaint about the Bow Goods Yard lights on 19 December 2018. The people it was sent to and the date it was sent are included within the email.

Please be advised that some information has been withheld under FOIA section 40 – personal information.

Section 40(2) –personal information

*(2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if –
(a) it constitutes personal data which does not fall within subsection (1), and
(b) the first, second or third condition below is satisfied.*

It is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information for those members of staff under Head of Service level, and for non-Legacy Corporation personnel unless consent to release the information has been received. Phone numbers have also been redacted.

The section 40 exemption is absolute and is not subject to the public interest test. In this instance, the relevant condition that applies is section 40(2) whereby the information is defined as personal data within s.3(2) of the Data Protection Act 2018.

Please accept my apologies, your complaint of 19 December 2018 was not raised with Tower Hamlets as stated in our response 20-028. They were contacted in relation to a later complaint and emailed on 31 January 2019 and this email has been attached in **Annex C**.
