Thank you for your information request, received on 24 February 2021. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*"I would be most grateful if you could provide me with details relating to Phase 4 (primary school) of Fish Island Village. Could you please confirm whether it is still in the LLDC's intentions to build a primary school on the site and what is the predicted timescale for a detailed planning application to be submitted. If the plan to build a primary school has been dropped could you please confirm the reasons behind it and what alternative uses/timescale is LLDC considering for the re-development of the site."*

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request. The "*The Planning Obligation by Agreement made pursuant to section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and other powers enabling relating to Neptune Wharf, Fish Island between (1) London Legacy Development Corporation (2) The Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, (3) Neptune Wharf Ltd, dated 27th March 2014*" contains the information you have requested and is publicly available on the Legacy Corporation planning register under the reference: [12/00210/OUT](#).
