Thank you for your information request, received on 25 November 2021. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"I am writing to politely request details of the amount of money that has been committed under Section 106 Planning Obligations but not spent for the following years: 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/2020 (and, if available, 2020/21)."

The information that you have requested can be found in the statutory annual Infrastructure Funding Statements published by the Legacy Corporation in its role as Local Planning Authority and CIL charging authority for its area.

The recently approved Infrastructure Funding Statement (IFS) for the year 2020/21 is attached in **Annex A**. This provides a comprehensive picture of CIL and S106 monies. The IFS for 2019/20 can be found on our website, link provided here: [IFS 2019/20](#). This provides the information on S106 sums held on a current cumulative basis rather than as an annual figure. Amounts allocated (committed) are also reported in the Annual Monitoring Reports (see below).

Prior to this, the statutory requirement was to publish this information in the form of a "Regulation 62 Report" for CIL money and the can be found on our website as follows:
