INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 21-034

Thank you for your information request, received on 1 December 2021. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Further to your email of 30 March 2021 [LLDC FOI 21-008], I hope you can assist me with a further query.

I attach a photograph of the bank located at near the Olympic Village/West Ham Stadium.

You will see there is a red circle identified "Location".

If you look carefully there is a trampled down fence in the red circle.

I understand that the fence may separate the land owned by Thames Water and LLDC.

Please could you assist me with the following:

- *Please confirm whether or not LLDC installed and maintained the trampled down fence? If so, when was it installed, repaired and inspected?*
- *Please confirm which part of the bank is LLDC land?"*



Please note: Our response to your previous request has been attached in **Annex A** for reference.

In regard to the fence up the bank, that you have circled in red in the above diagram, the Legacy Corporation did not install this fence and have no record of having ownership of this fence and no record of being responsible for its maintenance.

From a review of the Land Ownership map, the trampled down fence referenced in your request follows the Thames Water boundary as shown on the boundary plan attached in **Annex B**. The plan in **Annex B** has the approximate location on the path in question flagged in red. The chain link fence finishes at a Thames Water bridge. A photo of this is attached in **Annex C** and this location has also been flagged in yellow in the plan in **Annex B**.
