INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 23-011

Thank you for your information request, received on 16 March 2023. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Under freedom of information legislation can you provide me with the cost for external legal services relating to the London Stadium post Olympics use starting from the cost of the creation of the concessionaire agreement from Allen and Overy to date?”

While information is available on the stadium transparency website for all supplier invoices over £250, early years do not specify whether it was related to the stadium or not and some were tagged as professional services instead of legal so it is difficult to work.

Could you also break down the costs by legal firm and where available whether broken down by tenant or supplier for example West Ham United, Delaware North, Vinci, Newham Council, UK Athletics and others.”

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request. The information relevant to your request is below:
