**INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 23-037**

Thank you for your information request, received on 4 December 2023. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*“Please can you provide me with an account of the votes of all motions moved at the Planning Decisions Committee to either approve, refuse or defer a planning application between 1 May 2022 and 1 December 2023. I require how each member voted for every motion to ensure that votes were recorded accurately.”*

As a matter of practice, the Legacy Corporation do not record the votes of individuals, just the number for, against and abstentions on planning decisions.
