### 1. SUMMARY

## 3. ISSUES DISCUSSED

#### Executive Director of Regeneration and Community Partnerships' update

3.1. The Committee noted the Executive Director's report which provided an update on key projects across the work streams of socio-economic regeneration; equalities and inclusion; community and business engagement; arts and culture; and physical regeneration.

#### **Education update**

3.2. The Committee noted the report which provided an update on the work that the Legacy Corporation is undertaking to deliver the Legacy Communities Scheme schools; facilitate additional capacity in the Legacy Corporation's area; initiatives to inspire learning and build career pathways for young east Londoners; and engagement with a variety of Further Education and Higher Education institutes in the area. Following a positive resolution to exclude members of the press and public, in accordance with Part 1, paragraph 3 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended) the Committee also discussed and noted the appendix to this report which contained exempt information.

## Motivate East and the Paralympic Legacy Festival

- 3.3. The Committee noted the report which provided an update on the delivery of the Motivate East programme, a community disability sport programme inspired by the Paralympic Games which is a key element of the Legacy Corporations' Paralympic Legacy programme.
- 3.4. The Committee also noted the emerging and exciting plans for the Paralympic Legacy Festival to be held in the North Park on 7 September 2013 as the final event of the Legacy Corporation's summer events series.
