Thank you for your information request, received on 12 May 2025. I can confirm that London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC) holds information which falls within the scope of your request. You asked LLDC to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

Question 1

Do you have any business or contractual relationships with a company BLU-3 if so please could you provide information on the nature of the business and services provided by BLU-3 to you.

Response:

There is no current contractual relationship with Blu-3.

Blu-3 had the enabling works contract for LLDC's East Bank project at Stratford Waterfront from November 2018. The final payment to them by LLDC was made in April 2024.

Does BLU-3 provide any supplies or services to your organisation, if so what are these?

Blu-3 does not provide any supplies or services direct to LLDC.
