INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 25-021

Thank you for your information request, received on 12 March 2025. There has been several exchanges of emails and clarifications needed to respond to your request. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) for:

"In response to Arup's and LLDC landscape architect's comments, the applicant provided clarifications and further information on 21.12.2022, 13.03.2024 and 03.07.24."

Please can you provide these responses/clarification from the applicant and any other documentation related to electric charging points, ramps and drop kerbs around Imperial Phase 2.

The discharge of condition 16 (condition 17 landscape) included:

Hard landscape details shall include:

- a) details of proposed finished levels or contours including any alterations in existing ground levels.*
- b) car parking layouts including details of petrol and oil interceptors and electrical charging points.*
- c) details of all vehicle and pedestrian access points and circulation areas.*
- d) details of inclusive design including external steps and ramps, tactile warning or wayfinding paving, mobility features and dropped kerbs.*

I cannot see in the discharge of this application any documents relating to the provision of electric charging points, external ramps or dropped kerbs for Phase 2.

LLDC's hold the information you requested. Please see attached a **partial response** of information that relate to your request. I still have further information that I will be sending to you by Friday 19 December 2025.
