Yes, apologies I didn't get that sent out before heading away. For your records:

- 31st March 2025 was official end date of OPL operation of the Mobile Garden.
- This date also marked the handover of the physical asset from LLDC to Hackney Bridge (Vinegar Yard) to hold the asset as well as operate the Garden.
- We are open to you managing the garden in your own style and for you to explore commercial leads to make management of the garden viable for you, although we would hope the majority of use of the garden will be for the benefit of the local community, both new and existing.
- Within the management and ownership of the garden we would expect:
 - HB would maintain, provide security, check ins and be liable for, activity within the garden. You suggested potentially having sign ins for activity and garden users at the security office.
 - It's important to us to retain the beds allotted for allotment users. I understand you have already taken on the allotment users management in terms of communications, sign ins and any training you would need for them to be safe in the garden. Also to keep up to date the allotment users and ensure each bed is being utilised. I know there were some HB tenants interested in this too so maybe management here could come under volunteer management somewhere in the SLA.
 - There are 'garden reps' who were trained by OPL and currently access the garden when they like (via a sign up roster) to activate the garden and open it up to the public. I understand details have been handed to HB.
 - We need to maintain a number of wellbeing and free activities within the garden. There may be different pots of money and grants around for local community groups to run activity in the garden. HB will be taking on the operational side of scheduling in the activity, providing the space and contact for the different groups and engaging, coordinating and collaborating with local community initiatives. Groundwork, OPL and Badu both have committed activity still to run in the garden over the coming months.
 - HB to provide ongoing maintenance and safety of access within the garden.
 - Activity and benefit for the community will be reported back to the LLDC and HB steering group in written SLA reporting and regular meetings.

I know you mentioned you have brought on a new resource to help manage the garden too which is great.

Anything else you need from me as way of confirmation of handover, please do let me know!

Hi [REDACTED] and [REDACTED],

It was lovely to meet with you both yesterday!

I spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and had a few follow-up points.

1. IBC tanks that are collecting water. *They belong to the design of the garden, LLDC. But prefer not to change as they are very heavy and are part of the whole design of the garden.*
2. Storage. *Would it be possible for Hackney Bridge to use the black shipping container to keep tools in (it is very large and has 2 different compartments) and Groundwork to keep sole access to the white container? That way we avoid mixing up who's tools belong to who and would keep things simpler.*
3. Mobile Garden Signage on the wall facing the railway tracks. *Please do not move the sign, it is part of the garden design that Groundwork created and made with CSR volunteers. And designed as a back drop to the garden, and was made to be visible from the trains. It looks fantastic in photos when taking them in the garden and has become part of the identity in the new location. Agree more signage and perhaps a corporate day could help make something for another signage location.*
4. [REDACTED] taking on [REDACTED] work in the garden. *Would you be interested in a conversation, with option of booking [REDACTED] through Groundwork London, to do the work? How many Hours does [REDACTED] do a week?*

If this is done through Groundwork, we can also then ensure that his training, is kept up to date, provide cover when on leave and support with wider tasks, events and with corporate volunteering for the whole of the Hackney Bridge site's community aims.

I am on leave now for 10 days but will be in contact on my return.
