Thank you for attending the above MS Teams meeting. I have prepared some summary notes below; please feel free to make comments if I have missed anything.

Summary notes

Reference was made to the last meeting chaired by Peter Tudor, which focussed on finding a solution for displaying the two rings from the felled history trees at Chobham Manor and Endeavour Square. It was not felt that leaning the ring vertically or using them as back rests for circular seats was not suitable for safety and visitor access movement reasons, especially at Endeavour Square.

A detailed history of the trees, particularly the trees at Chobham Manor and Endeavour Square which both failed was given by [REDACTED].

Given the high cost of reinstating two history trees to original specification and the lack of available funding, it was agreed that we should focus on maintaining the remaining eight trees and promote the story of the History trees project via QR code links to Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park (QEOP) and Ackroyd & Harvey web sites and in the V&A museum, if the rings could be accepted there. This would make a nice adaptation to the History tree project and reference could also be made to the Spirit Ring at Endeavour Square.

It was agreed that the two new trees (Ulmus 'New Horizon') be planted to replace the missing Dawn Redwood at Endeavour Square and the Oak tree at Chobham Manor which was in a poor condition.

Actions

- Agreed that two new trees (Ulmus 'New Horizon' – semi-mature 40-45 cm circumference girth) be planted - one to replace the Dawn Redwood at Endeavour Square and one replace the English Oak (recently planted to replace the failed Copper Beech) at Chobham Manor. [REDACTED] to obtain a quotation from Idverde for this work and refer to Erin Wier for funding approval. [REDACTED] (Tree Consultant) would also be asked to confirm suitability of the Ulmus 'New Horizon' at these locations.
