**Introduction** The London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation) is committed to conduct all its business in accordance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, maintaining at all times the highest standards of integrity and accountability. The Legacy Corporation's Code of Conduct and Conflicts of Interest policy require all staff to declare any actual or potential conflict of interest between them and the financial or other interests or duties of the Legacy Corporation, either directly or indirectly (i.e. as a result of a staff member's relationship or connection with a third party). "body in which the Relevant Person has a beneficial interest" means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a Director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest unless: (i) the total nominal value of the securities is not more than £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued securities of that body; or (ii) if the securities of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest is not more than one hundredth of the total issued securities of that class. "Securities" means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.
